




### **Budget Instructions**

- Provided by the Office of Planning and Budget (August 1<sup>st</sup>)
- Request Limited: For <u>most</u> State Agencies the FY 2019 Budget
   Must Equal the FY 2018 Budget
- Exception: State Education Agencies May Request Workload Increases (Enrollment, M&O and Fringes)
- State is committed to fully funding pension obligations, investment in transportation infrastructure and funding growth needs in education
- FY 2018 Amended: No Change to Base Funding
