#### **CALL TO ORDER**

The Board of Regents of the University System of Georgia met on Tuesday, April 16, 2013, in the Savannah Ballroom at Armstrong Atlantic State University, Savannah, Georgia, and Wednesday, April 17, 2013, in the Student Union Building Ballroom at Savannah State University, Savannah, Georgia. The Chair of the Board, Regent William H. NeSmith, Jr., called the meeting to order at approximately 12:49 p.m. on Tuesday, April 16, and 9:18 a.m. on Wednesday, April 17. Present, in addition to Chair NeSmith, were Vice Chair Philip A. Wilheit, Sr.; and Regents C. Dean Alford; Kenneth R. Bernard, Jr.; Lori Durden; Larry R. Ellis; Rutledge A. Griffin, Jr.; George Hooks; C. Thomas Hopkins, Jr.; Kessel D. Stelling, Jr.; Donald M. Leebern, Jr.; Doreen Stiles Poitevint; Neil L. Pruitt, Jr.; Benjamin J. Tarbutton, III; Richard L. Tucker; T. #### APPROVAL OF MINUTES

The minutes of the Board of Regents meeting conducted on March 12, 15, and 22, 2013, were unanimously approved.

#### INTRODUCTION OF NEW STAFF AND REGENT

At approximately 12:58 p.m. Tuesday, April 16, Executive Vice Chancellor for Academic Affairs Houston Davis introduced to the Board Mr. Mark F. Lytle, Vice Chancellor of Economic Development. Chair NeSmith introduced and welcomed new Regent Don L. Waters.

#### **RECOGNITION OF SPECIAL GUESTS**

Executive Vice Chancellor for Administration Steve Wrigley on Tuesday, April 16, thanked Mr. Lee Richey for having served as interim Vice Chancellor for Real Estate and Facilities. Chair NeSmith on Wednesday, April 17, recognized and welcomed to the Board meeting Savannah Mayor Edna Branch Jackson.

### SPECIAL PRESENTATIONS: ARMSTRONG ATLANTIC STATE UNIVERSITY; SAVANNAH STATE UNIVERSITY

Armstrong Atlantic State University President Linda Bleicken welcomed the Board of Regents to Armstrong Atlantic State University at approximately 12:59 p.m. on Tuesday, April 16; Savannah State University President Cheryl Dozier welcomed the Board of Regents to Savannah State University at approximately 9:25 a.m. on Wednesday, April 17. Both presidents extolled their institutions' merits and achievements, and information regarding their academic offerings and campus cultures; and presented histories of their

information regarding their academic offerings and campus cultures; and presented histories of their universities' respective establishment. President Bleicken invited three AASU students to address the Board, recounting their experiences at the university. Copies of both presentations are on file with, and available for inspection in, the Office of the Secretary to the Board.

#### **COMMITTEE OF THE WHOLE: COMMITTEE ON FINANCE & BUSINESS OPERATIONS**

The Committee on Finance & Business Operations, meeting as the Committee of the Whole, met at approximately 12:59 p.m. Tuesday, April 16, 2013. Committee Chair Kenneth Bernard introduced Vice Chancellor for Finance John Brown, who presented to the Board of Regents a budget recap of the Fiscal Year 2013 Amended Budget, and the Fiscal Year 2014 Budget, following the 2013 legislative session.

HB 105 amended FY 2013 budget from an original \$1.829 billion to the final, amended state funds budget of \$1.75 billion, a decrease of 4.44 percent. Next, the Committee received information on the FY 2014 Budget, HB 106. The state funds FY 2014 budget, as represented in HB 106, is \$1.88 billion, including \$1.68 billion in formula funds and \$207 million in all other line items. The FY 2014 budget represents a total net increase of \$54.6 million, or 2.98 percent. Those figures are attached as Appendix I.

1. The Board approved a FY 2014 tuition increase of 2.5 percent for institutions across all sectors, except for the Georgia Institute of Technology (7 percent), Georgia Regents University (3.5 percent), Georgia State University (3.5 percent), and the University of Georgia (5 percent).

The Board further approved an increase to out-of-state tuition by the same percentage for all institutions, except the Georgia Institute of Technology, Georgia Regents University, Georgia State University, and the University of Georgia, for which out-of-state tuition will increase by the same dollar amount as in-state tuition.

- 2. The Board approved a revision to the Policy Manual, Section 7.3.1.1, Definitions, relating to the "Finish-In-Four" Tuition Model for Georgia Regents University.
- 3. The Board approved the FY 2014 mandatory fees and fee increases. The approved amounts are contained in Appendix III.
- 4. The Board approved the repurposing of the \$50 of the UGA Student Center Facility Fee, effective summer semester 2013, to fund the renovation and expansion of the Tate Center, and to support the continued operations of the Ramsey Center.
- 5. The Board approved the allocation of state appropriations for FY 2014 among institutions and operating units of the University System of Georgia, which is outlined in Appendix IVB and Appendix IVC. All allocations for FY 2014 are pending the Governor's signing of House Bill 106, the Appropriations Act for FY 2014.

#### SPECIAL PRESENTATION: DESIRE2LEARN

Vice Chancellor for Information Technology Services Curt Carver and Georgia Regents University Vice President for Academic & Faculty Affairs Carol Rychly presented an informational item to the Board at approximately 9:57 a.m. Wednesday, April 17, concerning Desire2Learn. Desire2Learn is the USG's learning management system, providing students with a centralized location on the web to access all of their courses and materials. Faculty and students can use the system in traditional classroom settings, hybrid courses, and online classes. A full copy of Drs. Carver's and Rychly's presentation is on file with, and available for inspection in, the Office of the Secretary to the Board.

#### SPECIAL PRESENTATION: JACKSON SPALDING

Executive Vice Chancellor for Academic Affairs Houston Davis and Mr. Brian Brodrick, a partner with communications firm Jackson Spalding, made a presentation at approximately 10:16 a.m. Wednesday, April 17, regarding Complete College Georgia, focusing on how to best promote that effort; improve its overall messaging and marketing strategies; fully engage returning students and adult learners; and position education as the pathway to a better life in Georgia. #### LEGISLATIVE UPDATE

The Chancellor stated the USG continues to smooth the integrations of the consolidated institutions, even as it receives inquiries from around the county regarding this process. Last, Chancellor Huckaby recognized Dr. Houston Davis for his attention to strategic imperatives. 8.2.8.4 Career State Employees Eligibility for Retirement with Health and Life Benefits
A State of Georgia employee who transfers to the University System of Georgia without a break in service shall be eligible to retire with Health and Life benefits provided that on the date of his/her separation of employment:

- 1. He/she has attained age 60 and he/she has a minimum of ten (10) years of service established with a State of Georgia sponsored retirement plan; the last 12 months of employment must have been served with the USG; or,
- 2. He/she has a total of twenty-five (25) years of service established with a State of Georgia sponsored retirement plan, regardless of age; the last 12 months days must have been served with the USG.

An employee must be enrolled in the Health and Life benefits coverage at the time of retirement in order to continue coverage in retirement.

An individual, who has retired from another State of Georgia sponsored retirement plan, may not count such retirement service toward meeting the criteria for being a career employee (BoR Minutes, October 2002).

### MINUTES OF THE MEETING OF THE COMMITTEE ON REAL ESTATE AND FACILITIES

The Committee on Real Estate and Facilities of the Board of Regents of the University System of Georgia met at approximately 4:04 p.m. on Tuesday, April 16, 2013, in the Savannah Ball Room of Armstrong Atlantic State University, Savannah, Georgia. The chair of the committee, Regent Kessel D. Stelling, called the meeting to order. Present, in addition to Regent Stelling, were Regents Kenneth R. Bernard, Jr.; George Hooks; Donald M. Leebern, Jr.; Doreen Stiles Poitevint; Richard L. Tucker; Larry Walker; and Don L. Waters. Regent E. Scott Smith was excused. Also present was Board Chair William H. NeSmith.

- 1. The committee heard an integrated evaluation of campus facilities-related proposals at Georgia Highlands College, the Georgia Institute of Technology, Georgia Regents University, Kennesaw State University, and the University of Georgia.
  - The next step involves the appropriate level of detailed development including definition of scope, all due diligence, financing and requisite authorizations by the Board. This stage of detailed analysis will continue to involve Academic, Fiscal Affairs and Audit.
- 2. The Board declared approximately 9.20 acres of unimproved real property located on Georgia Route 20, Cartersville, to be no longer advantageously useful to the University System of Georgia, but only to the extent and for the purpose of allowing the sale of this real property to the Georgia Department of Transportation for the benefit of the USG.

The Board further declared approximately 3.40 acres of unimproved real property located at Georgia Route 20, Cartersville, to be no longer advantageously useful to the USG, but only to the extent and for the purpose of granting non-exclusive easements to GDOT for use of slope construction and maintenance.

The Board authorized the sale and granting of non-exclusive easements of the above referenced real property to GDOT for \$2,209,490. Legal details involved with the sale and granting of nonexclusive easements of the above referenced real property be handled by the Georgia Department of Law.

- 3. The Board accepted a gift of approximately 15.45 acres of real property located at 7601 Skidaway Road, Savannah, from the Trustees of the Wormsloe Foundation, Inc., for the use and benefit of the University of Georgia. The Board accepted an access easement from the State of Georgia to obtain access to this real property. Legal details involved with accepting this gift of real property will be handled by the Georgia Department of Law.
- 4. The Board authorized a revision to an acquisition of real property on Georgia Highway 15, Oconee and Greene Counties, first approved at the November 2012 Board of Regents meeting. The Board authorized the purchase of approximately 660.48 acres of agriculturally improved real property located on Georgia Highway 15 in Oconee and Greene Counties, from L.C. Curtis & Son, Inc. for \$2,641,920 for the use and benefit of the University of Georgia, with funding available from proceeds from the sale of portions of the former Institute of Genetics property. Proceeds from the sale of the Plant Sciences Farm will be used to replenish these funds, at such time as the Plant Sciences Farm is sold.
- 5. The Board approved modification to the budget of Project No. PPV-66-1301A, Paulson Stadium Expansion, and Project No. PPV-66-1301B, Football Operations Center, at Georgia Southern

University, to increase the total project budget from \$23,119,000 to \$25,600,000. This budget modification is for increased estimated project cost, including a scoreboard not part of the original project budget. The Stated Cost Limitation will increase from \$16,300,000 to \$17,318,120. Funding of this cost increase of \$2,481,000 will be from the Georgia Southern University Athletic Foundation and the Georgia Southern University Foundation, and will be held in a restricted account for this project until project completion.

- 7. The Board approved the naming of the Honors House at the University of West Georgia as the "Don R. Wagner Honors House," in recognition of Dr. Donald R. Wagner.
- 8. The Board approved the naming of the Business Learning Community Phase I Building at the University of Georgia as "Correll Hall," in recognition of Pete and Ada Lee Correll.
